- Roadways:** Greenfield Siliguri-Shillong-Silchar Expressway, reducing the travel time between Srirampur to Silchar to 9 hours, Gohpur-Numaligarh underwater road-cum-rail tunnel across the Brahmaputra, four-lane highway from Baihata Chariali to Tezpur, Guwahati Ring Road, Guwahati-Tinsukia Expressway via Dibrugarh, taking advantage of the Kaziranga Elevated Corridor and special initiatives for construction and upgradation of all roads and bridges across the BTR
- Railways:** Introducing Vande Bharat trains on key routes, including Guwahati-Dibrugarh, Guwahati-Agartala via Silchar and Guwahati-North Lakhimpur
- Airways:** Greenfield airports in Manas, Umrangso, Charaideo, Diphu, Majuli and Doloo
- Waterways:** Water Metro System in Guwahati, Dibrugarh and Tezpur; Bogibeel, Pandu and Jogighopa integrated river logistics hubs; Cruise Terminals at Neamati, Silghat, Biswanath Ghat, Guijan and Baihata Terminal
